

**FLODRAULIC INDUSTRIAL SRL, FLODRAULIC EUROPE SRL, FLODRAULIC MOTION SYSTEMS SRL, FLODRAULIC FLUID CONVEYANCE SRL and EBI MOTION CONTROLS SRL**, acting as **Joint Data Controllers** (hereinafter “Joint Controllers”), pursuant to **EU Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR)** and the applicable national legislation on personal data protection, intend to provide users with information regarding the processing carried out through cookies installed on this website (hereinafter the “Site”).

---

#### WHAT COOKIES ARE

This Site uses **cookies**, which are text files stored on the User’s device or that allow access to information on the User’s device.

Cookies allow the Site to:

- store information about visitors’ preferences;
- verify the proper functioning of the Site;
- improve the browsing experience by expanding functionality and personalizing page content according to the type of browser used;
- analyze how visitors use the Site.

---

#### TYPES OF COOKIES

The Site uses the following categories of cookies:

##### NECESSARY OR TECHNICAL COOKIES

Necessary cookies help make the Site usable by enabling basic functions such as page navigation and access to secure areas of the Site.

The Site cannot function properly without these cookies.

##### STATISTICAL OR ANALYTICAL COOKIES

Statistical cookies help website owners understand how visitors interact with the Site by collecting and reporting information anonymously.

##### MARKETING COOKIES

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors across websites.

Their purpose is to display advertisements that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and therefore more valuable for publishers and third-party advertisers.

---

#### COOKIE MANAGEMENT

Upon the User’s **first access to the Site**, a banner is displayed containing a brief notice about how cookies are managed by the Joint Controllers and the choices available to the User, with the possibility of obtaining further information by consulting the extended policy.

Before continuing to browse the Site, the User must indicate their preferences regarding the installation of optional cookies on their browser, by providing or withholding consent for their use. The User may:

- accept all cookies by clicking the “**Accept all**” button;
- refuse them by clicking the “**Reject**” button within the banner;
- alternatively choose each specific type of cookie by selecting them individually through the “**Accept selected**” option.

The switch command used to activate or deactivate optional cookies is set **by default to “Disabled.”**

---

#### HOW TO DISABLE COOKIES FROM THE BROWSER

Users may disable the use of cookies **at any time** by withdrawing the consent previously given by clicking the button located at the **bottom left corner of the Site**.

---

#### USER RIGHTS

At any time, Users may exercise the rights granted under the **GDPR (Articles 15–22)** by contacting any of the Joint Controllers, including in particular the right to:

##### Access

to obtain confirmation as to whether personal data concerning them is being processed, as well as further information regarding the processing described in this policy, and to receive such data within reasonable limits.

##### Rectification

to obtain correction or completion of the data provided or otherwise held by the Joint Controllers if inaccurate.

#### **Erasure**

to request deletion of data collected or processed by the Joint Controllers if it is no longer necessary for the purposes described above, if no disputes or legal claims are pending, in the event of withdrawal of consent or objection to processing, in case of unlawful processing, or where there is a legal obligation to delete it.

#### **Restriction of processing**

to obtain a temporary limitation of the processing of personal data by the Joint Controllers where one of the conditions under Article 18 GDPR applies.

#### **Data portability**

to receive their data or have it transmitted to another data controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. Users may also **withdraw their consent at any time**, without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to the withdrawal of consent.

Finally, Users have the right to **lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority** (Art. 77 GDPR).
